First Baptist Youth program helps kids grow in their walk with God

For the past four years, I've had the joy of serving as Youth Director. Many people have asked why I volunteered for this role,



and my answer is simple: I want my children to experience the same kind of youth group I was blessed with here at First Baptist Church many years ago.

Today's youth face a very different world than we did. They attend 12 different schools, juggle sports and activities nearly every day – including Wednesdays and Sundays – and navigate the challenges of social media and cell phones.

But one thing hasn't changed. They are still searching for belonging. Middle and high school are critical years when young people begin shaping their identity, making decisions and figuring out where they fit.

My deepest desire is that every youth who walks into FBC Clayton knows this: you belong here, you are supported through good times and bad, you can grow in your faith, and you are LOVED.

By God's grace, our youth group has more than tripled in size over the past four years. We now have over 60 students on our roster – and always room for more!

Our Youth Council meets monthly to plan activities that engage and encourage our youth to stay connected.

Sunday Mornings: We've launched a new Sunday School class called Bible Life! – Read It! Live It! Our teachers are leading students to dive into Scripture in ways that make it personal and exciting, helping them grow in their relationship with God.

Wednesday Nights (30/60/30) Modified to suit the Youth

- 30 minutes of Praise and Worship with the congregation
- 60 minutes of small group devotions, games and youth-focused worship
- 30 minutes of optional fellowship and fun These nights are designed to spark meaningful conversations about real-life challenges, equipping youth with biblical tools to navigate their world. This year, we'll be using a book "YOUnique" to help students
